Our emission to water and air is affected by the products we handle and activities we carry out, and knowledge about each product and the interaction between the products is therefore extremely important. We will assure that we possess necessary information about products' environmental impact, so we can plan our activities and take precautions aligned with the potential environmental consequences. Additionally, our procedures and daily routines contain prevention against spillage, since prevention of spillage is essential for the environment. Should spillage still take place, we have tried to minimize the potential effects for the environment by means of our emergency plan and training of our staff. We re-use packaging materials extensively and dispose it for re-cycling afterwards.

By open communication we work to achieve the best possible solutions to benefit the environment.
